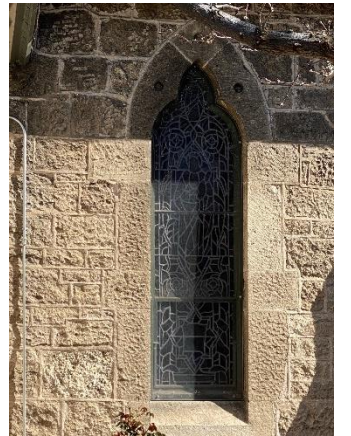

4. This structure was built in 1921 and placed on the national register in 1985. The historic significance focuses on the diversity of the religion.

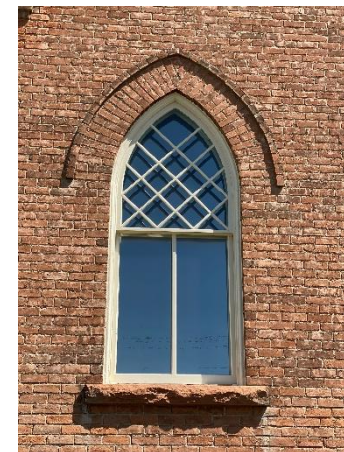

6. This building was built in 1902 in classic gothic style. This red brick building and was later moved to a different site in 2012.

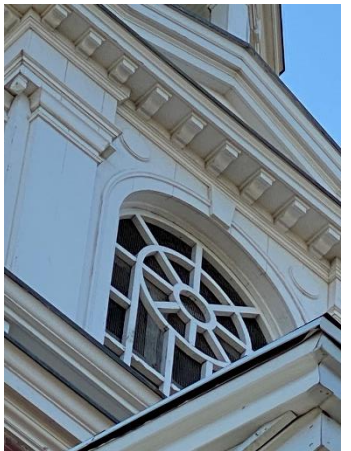

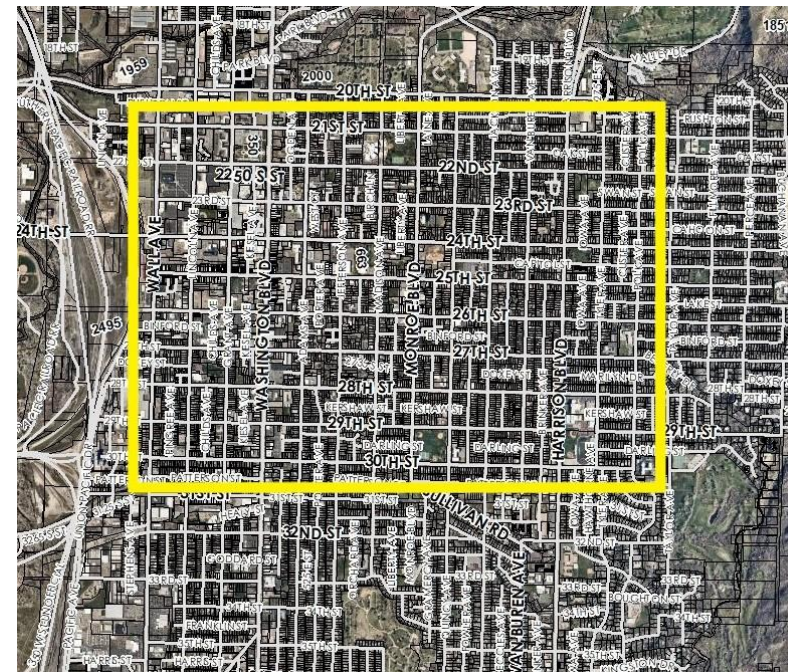
RULES
