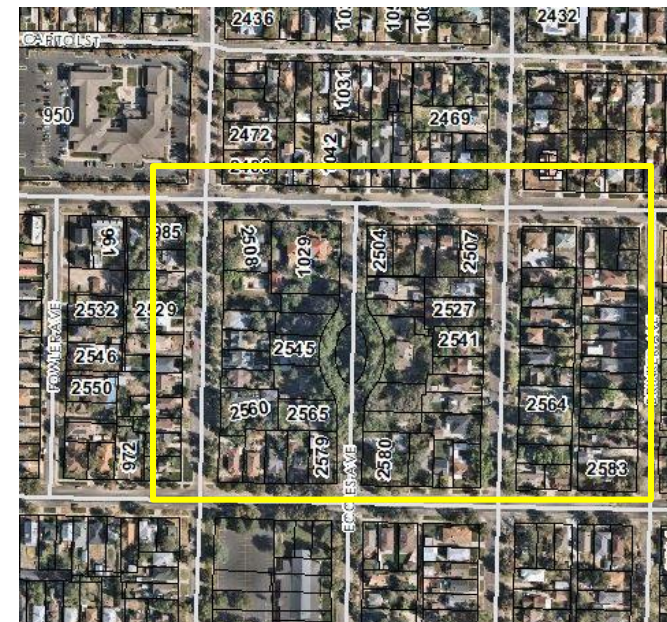
### RULES
