

# OGD FULL AIRPORT CLOSURES & A 15-DAY CLOSURE OF RUNWAY 17-35



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## **FULL OGD AERODROME AIRPORT CLOSURES**

The Airport will be working with Blade Helicopter to conduct some aerial spraying of herbicide to more efficiently spray the weeds on the airfield. This will occur in the early morning hours from 5:30 am to 09:30 am on Tuesday July 5th and then again, on Wednesday July 6th (same hours). I remind everyone that this begins before the ATC Tower opens. There will be a NOTAM issued on Sunday morning July 3rd. This is the earliest I can issue the NOTAM. The

FAA's NOTAM Manager software will not allow a NOTAM to be published more than 72 hours prior to the event.

The herbicide being used is the same herbicide that has been used at the Airport for the past 20 years. We are hoping that we can accomplish in less than a week, what would usually take more than a month using the ground based equipment. As of this writing, the weather looks good for this spraying, but if the weather radically changes from the forecast, I may have to postpone the work.

### **15-DAY CLOSURE OF RUNWAY 17-35**

Granite Construction has completed the sub-base and the base course for the foundation of the new partial parallel taxiway west of the approach end of Runway 17. Beginning this coming Wednesday, July 6th, Granite Construction will begin to tie into Runway 17-35 from the new taxiway. This tie in will require closing the entire length of Runway 17-35 for 15 calendar days. It is expected that the closure will last until Thursday July 21st. Granite Construction will be working seven days a week to accomplish this tie in.

It should go without saying, but construction is a never-ending function at Airports and we cannot improve the Airport without invasive construction. This construction project will begin what is planned to be a full parallel taxiway running on the Airport's west side, from the north end of Runway 17-35 to the south end of Runway 3-21.
